WATERING INSTRUCTIONS

FOR ANNUALS



Watering For All Seasons

- As soon as your annuals have been installed give them a thorough soak
- Water slowly until you see water seep out any drainage holes
- As plants grow larger and the root system expands water needs will increase
- Check soil moisture regularly
 - Use your finger to test the soil if the top inch feels dry it's time to water

SPRING



Spring weather can be unpredictable so check soil moisture regularly

Warm & Sunny



Water once a day

Cool & Cloudy



Water once a week



First Week After Install - Water daily



After First Week - Water 3X a week



Hot Weather Alert - Water every other day (80s/90s)



SUMMER

FALL





First Week After Install - Water daily



Warm Weather - Water daily / every other day (70s/80s)



Cool Weather - Water 1-2X a week (50s/60s)



Freeze Warning - Make sure soil is moist for root insulation



After install water annuals a few times before soil freezes solid to ensure greens are well-hydrated

Give annuals a drink if temperatures rise above freezing over the winter months
